Authors guidelines

Participation as an author to a poster session involves an automat. registration to the conference (reduced poster presenter registration fee: per person € 650).

Poster presentations are gaining importance at conferences as an instructive means of showing ideas, research or products and discussing them intensely with others.

To be sure that a poster is generally accepted, it is important to carefully consider content and design. This is a necessary precondition to obtain the intended response for the underlying work. As far as the content is concerned, the most important aspects should be concisely presented and clearly arranged. Generally these consist of a problem, the suggested solution, or solving method, and the result.

1 - Poster disposition and set-up

1.1 – Poster size

It's an A0-format: 1189 mm (height) x 841 mm (wide). It's a portrait format.

Size poster wall: height 233,0 cm, width 94,0 cm.

Text, tables and illustrations have to be arranged on this surface and be clearly legible at a distance of 1.5 to 2 m (about 6 feet).

1.2 – Indications for poster preparation

The text must be in English.

The title of the poster, the category, and the name of the author(s) should appear on top right corner of your poster. We recommend that your company name or logo is also indicated on your poster.

We suggest you use the example enclosed.

To improve understanding, you may wish to distinguish clearly the introduction, results and conclusions. Plans, diagrams, photographs and illustrations can represent 50% of your poster for enjoyable reading.

To protect posters: you may plastic cover them or print on PVC.

The authors will be able to discuss and explain their research to others during their dedicated poster sessions. To this effect, you may want to prepare hand-outs for distribution.

1.3 – Planning of Poster session

It is the authors' responsibility to secure and safekeep their own laptops if they take one. Kindly note that the poster areas will be accessible at all times. **For information electricity is not available on the poster areas.**

The posters will be displayed in a dedicated space inside the **conference center** Hôtel Le Palais de La Méditerranée. The address is: 13-15, Promenade des Anglais - BP 1655 - 06000 Nice, France. It is recommended that authors bring and fix their poster, on Tuesday, 9th December 2008, from 16:00 pm.

The boards will be set up and numbered at your arrival.

You will be welcomed by 3rd IC RES & DER staff, and will be shown to your posterboard.

During the poster sessions, members of the Jury for a special price will discuss posters with the authors, according to the categories. The programme is as follows:

Wednesday 10th December

6:30 PM First Poster Session linked to a Wine Tasting event

Thursday 11th December

6:30 PM Second Poster Session Linked to a Wine Tasting Event

Friday 11th December

4:30 PM Award Ceremony

Posters must be made so as to be able to fix them immediately on the boards (velcro pellets will be provided by the committee) please note that it is forbidden to write on the poster boards.

Authors are not asked to be present by their poster at all time, their presence is requested during their specific poster sessions.

Posters must be removed Friday after the conference. Please note that after 6 pm posters still set-up will be trashed (no shipping will be accepted).

During poster sessions your only means of communication are posters and laptops, no other form of media is accepted (television, special equipment etc ...).

2 – The RES & DER Awards

A prize will be awarded for the first time at the 3rd International Conference on integration of RES & DER. A panel of experts from the Scientific Committee will choose an award winning paper from the papers selected for the poster sessions for the Nice conference. The winner will be announced on Friday 11th December 2008 around 5:00 PM, by Chantal Jouanno, President, ADEME, FR* and Marc Florette, Research & Innovation Vice-President, GDF SUEZ, and will receive a certificate and an award. So, please be present at that moment.
